In 1981 the Harley Davidson Company was owned by a parent WARM UP company called AMF. Because Harley's profits were very slim the parent company sold the company to the top management

people at Harley Davidson for a price of 80 million dollars. Their purpose was to make the best motorcycle possible and to compete on a global basis. Twenty-nine years and thousands and thousands of bikes later, their purpose has not changed. They have grown from producing 35,000 bikes yearly to 132,000 - generating 1.7 billion dollars in revenue and competing on a global scale.

2,000 years ago, Jesus bought us back for a purpose. He started with 12 men and the church has grown to millions. When God breaks into history and grips a man's life, it is for a purpose. People are saved to serve. When God lays hold of a man, woman or child, He has a key role for them to play in the unfolding of His redemptive plan for the world.



BACKGROUND

Have you ever wondered why, when you turn your life over to God, you don't just get expressfreighted right to heaven? This single verse of Scripture, Ephesians 2:10, sheds as much light on the situation as anything else: "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works which God prepared in advance for us to do". 


OUESTIONS
