WHAT IS MAN?



WARM UP

Using a chemical supply catalogue, a professor of the University of Washington recently calculated the value of marketable substances in a normal 140 pound man. At today's prices, for example, the body's 10,200 units of a certain clotting agent would sell for \$30,600. The 40gms of myoglobin are worth \$100,000. The professor says that our plasma is worth more than the \$10 a pint hospitals pay for it. Each pint has 30gms of albumin - which alone is worth \$945. According to him, the human body is worth around one million dollars.
